## **A Tribute to Major (Ret'd.) Jean-Paul LeBlanc, CD (VE9BK)**

### **Biography of Major (Ret'd) Jean-Paul LeBlanc, CD**

Major Jean-Paul LeBlanc, born on August 19, 1950, in Moncton, New Brunswick, has led a distinguished career in the Canadian Armed Forces, marked by dedication, expertise, and leadership. A graduate of Ecole Secondaire Vanier, his military journey began with five years in the 560 Moncton Army Cadet Corps, followed by two and a half years with the 8th Canadian Hussars (Princess Louise's) (Militia), where he achieved the rank of Master Corporal.

Enlisting in the Regular Force as a Private in 1970, Major LeBlanc's foundational training at CFB Cornwallis and subsequent specialization in Signals Intelligence at CFS Gloucester set the stage for a series of impactful postings. His early career saw him serving at CFS Gander, Echo Squadron at the Canadian Forces School of Communications and Electronics, 770 Communication Research Squadron, CFS Bermuda, and as a recruiter in Corner Brook, Newfoundland. His operational commitment included four tours at CFS Alert, demonstrating his dedication to Canada's northern sovereignty.

Commissioned from the rank of Warrant Officer in 1986, Major LeBlanc's officer career was equally illustrious. Following further training at CFB Kingston, he served in key technical and leadership roles at 226 Radar Squadron, 764 Communication Squadron, Communication Squadron Lahr, and the Canadian Forces Naval Engineering School in Halifax. His tenure as Staff Officer Information Resources Management (G6) at CFB Borden before retiring in 1999 highlights his significant contributions to military communications and information management.

Post-retirement, Major LeBlanc continued to serve the community and the nation through his work with the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services in Ontario and his leadership role in the Communications Reserve at 700 (Borden) Communications Squadron.

Throughout his career, Major LeBlanc has been recognized for his expertise in advanced data and satellite communications, electronic warfare, information technology security, and more. His commitment to professional development and bilingualism, alongside his operational and leadership excellence, has been honored with the Canadian Forces Decoration and the Special Service Medal, among other accolades.

Married to Pauline Downer, with whom he shares three daughters and six grandchildren, Major LeBlanc's legacy extends beyond his military achievements. An avid amateur radio operator, his involvement in emergency communications and the Canadian Forces Amateur Radio System (CFARS) underscores his ongoing commitment to service and community.

Major LeBlanc's career embodies the values of dedication, innovation, and leadership, making him a respected figure in both military and amateur radio communities. His contributions continue to inspire those who have the privilege of knowing him or learning of his remarkable journey.
